



When snow and ice hinder refuse collection

Safety first!

There may currently be disruptions to waste collection due to snow and ice on the roads. Some collections may start later or be cancelled altogether due to road conditions (the collection on 9 January is cancelled throughout the district).

Our colleagues in the vehicles are doing their best during these days. In these weather conditions, they need the support of our customers even more. **The main priority is to clear and grit slippery pavements and ensure free access to waste bins.**

If a collection has to be cancelled, the following rules apply:

Residual waste:



Neutral bags can be placed next to the bin for the next regular collection. The bags must be tied shut.
Residual waste with 4-weekly collection: These bins can be put out for collection on the next residual waste collection day in 14 days.

Organic waste:



For the next regular collection, excess quantities can be placed in cardboard boxes or paper bags next to the bin. The bags must be tied shut.

Recycling bin:



For the next regular collection, you can place neutral transparent bin bags next to the bin. Important: Black or blue bags must remain in the bin!

Paper:



Shred paper and cardboard to create more space in the bin. If necessary, use the free delivery service for paper and cardboard at the recycling centres or, in exceptional cases, bundle excess quantities or pack them in cardboard boxes next to the bin for the next regular collection.
